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Dr. Zoltán Rihmer, Md, PhD, DSc, received his medical diploma in 1971. He received his PhD at the Hungarian Academy of Sciences in 1993, and his DSc in 2004.

Since then he has been working at the National Institute for Psychiatry and Neurology, Budapest, Hungary.

From 2007 he is professor of psychiatry at the Department of Psychiatry and Psychotherapy, and scientific director at the Department of Clinical and Theoretical Mental Health, Semmelweis University, Faculty of Medicine, Budapest.
